FACT: 70% of construction workers who die from electrocutions are NOT electricians.

FACT: Electricity can do more than just shock...burns, internal injuries and falls can result from coming in contact with electricity.

FACT: Even a small amount of electricity can be fatal; electrocutions can happen in less than a second.

FACT: Using scaffolding, metal ladders, heavy equipment, and aluminum extension poles or long-handled metal tools too close to live electric current puts workers at risk of electrocution.

- ⇒ New curriculum for training workers that includes a powerpoint and numerous teaching resources
- ⇒ Training about electrical hazards and preventing exposure
- ⇒ Special guest presentation from Cal/OSHA
