



Don't Be Fooled By Liberal Labor Union Smear of Russ Bogh

Republican Leaders Send Warning to 37th Senate District Voters

RIVERSIDE, Calif. - Riverside County Republican leaders are encouraging local voters not to believe "hit" mailers and "dirty tricks" from liberal labor unions that are attempting to smear Republican Senate candidate and Riverside County businessman Russ Bogh.

"Conservative leaders like Russ Bogh are often the subject of attacks like this from liberal labor unions," said Former Sergeant of Arms of Republican State Party, Jim Stuart.
